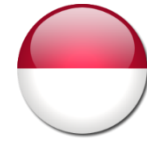

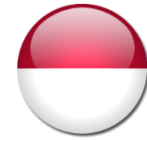

- TV Big screen;





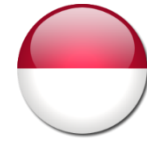

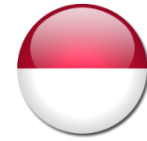
STRATEGY
