BACKGROUND

- The 10th Senior Officials' Meeting (SOM-10) held on 5-7 November 2014 in Dili, Timor-Leste confirmed the dates of deposit with the Depository (i.e. Indonesia) of instruments of acceptance or approval or ratification by the four members of CTI-CFF
- In accordance with Article 17 of the Agreement on the Establishment of the Regional Secretariat of the CTI-CFF, the entry into force of the Agreement on the Establishment of CTI-CFF Regional Secretariat was effective on 27 November 2014
