- Baseline data collection



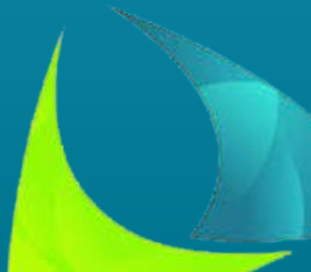
UPDATE REGARDING DEVELOPMENT OF NPOA (NATIONAL PLAN OF ACTION)

- The PNG Marine Program is currently under review to align with the RPOA 2.0. The expected reviewed document to be available first quarter of 2024

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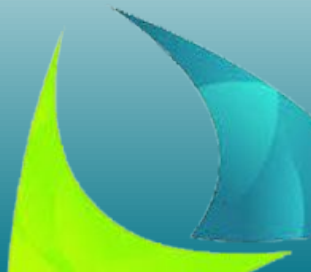

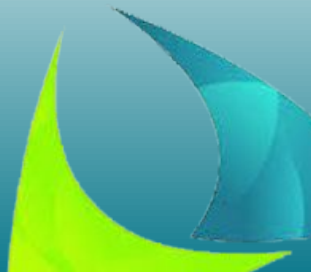
CHALLENGES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MONITORING, EVALUATION AND LEARNING IN REGARD TO RPOA 2.0 (BASELINE DATA AND UPDATE INFORMATION)

1. In relation to the **Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework (KM-GBF) 30x30 Targets**, the Philippines is still identifying other areas to increase the area extent to be committed, other than the existing marine protected areas.
 - a. *OECM*
 - b. *Fisheries Management Areas - needing harmonization with other protected areas to avoid duplication.*



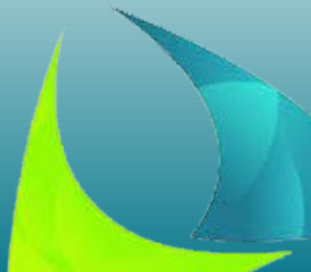
CHALLENGES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MONITORING, EVALUATION AND LEARNING IN REGARD TO RPOA 2.0 (BASELINE DATA AND UPDATE INFORMATION)

1. **The country is developing/updating the National State of the Ocean and Coasts (NSOC) Report covering 2019-2024, in the same phase with NPOA 2.0 development, to be presented in the East Asian Seas (EAS) Congress on 2024. The NSOC Report will feed in as baseline of the NPOA 2.0.** There is a need to develop the NSOC Report first before the NPOA 2.0.



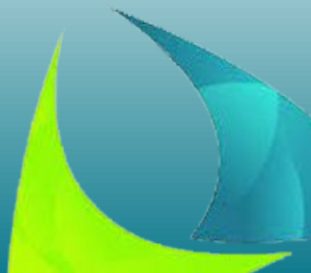
CHALLENGES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MONITORING, EVALUATION AND LEARNING IN REGARD TO RPOA 2.0 (BASELINE DATA AND UPDATE INFORMATION)

2. The Monitoring and Evaluation Plan Framework of NPOA 2.0 is yet to be developed, thus, there is no consolidated baseline information for all related initiatives by the National Government Agencies, Civil Society Organizations, Development Partners and private individuals.



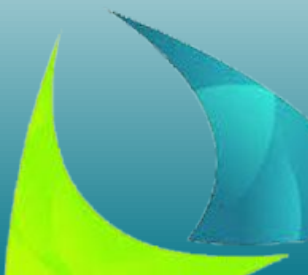

 - For ease of coordination.



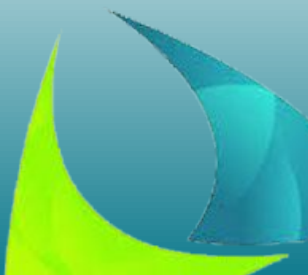

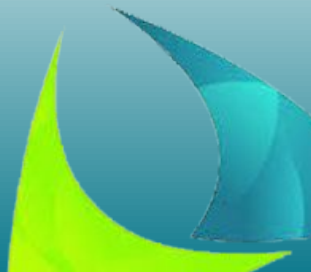

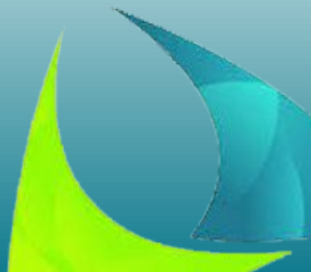

The Department of Environment and Natural Resources-Biodiversity Management Bureau (DENR-BMB) and the Department of Agriculture-Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (DA-BFAR) jointly serve as the Secretariat for the Philippine National CTI-CFF Coordinating Committee (PH NCCC), as mandated by Executive Order No. 797, issued in 2009. In this capacity, DENR-BMB and DA-BFAR actively engage in the CTI-CFF Regional Secretariat's activities, meetings, and programs, including the annual Senior Officials' Meeting and biennial Ministerial Meeting.

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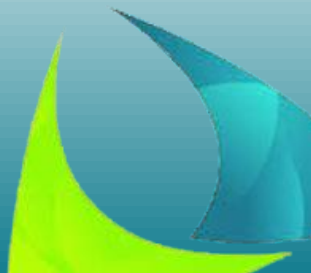
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

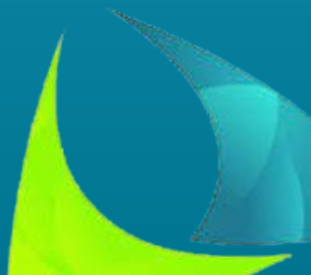
UPDATE FROM CT6 REGARDING DEVELOPMENT OF NPOA (NATIONAL PLAN OF ACTION)
